Known Issue with Legacy CMS Lessons on Chrome

Opening a Legacy CMS lesson often results in an error – especially after opening a CMS lesson once already (opening same lesson again or opening another CMS lesson).

This is the error the user will see:

When this occurs, the user must close the browser window, login to the OLS again, and re-open the lesson. This needs to be done each time another CMS based lesson is opened. This only occurs in Chrome – using another browser such as Firefox will prevent this from occurring.
